The program will include keynote lectures, clinical case discussions, interactive sessions, young investigator presentations, poster sessions, and practical workshops designed to connect research, clinical decision-making, and compassionate communication. Special attention will be given to the role of young oncologists in clinical trials, real-world evidence, digital oncology, multidisciplinary teamwork, and ethical implementation of new technologies.
